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## THE FOLLOWING DISEASES MUST BE REPORTED TO THE HEALTH DEPARTMENT WITHIN 3 WORKING DAYS AFTER IDENTIFICATION

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| <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Acquired Immunodeficiency Syndrome (AIDS)</li> <li>▪ Adverse event resulting after smallpox vaccination</li> <li>▪ Amebiasis</li> <li>▪ Arbovirus infection (including St. Louis encephalitis &amp; West Nile virus)</li> <li>▪ Brucellosis</li> <li>▪ Campylobacteriosis</li> <li>▪ Chancroid</li> <li>▪ Chickenpox (varicella)</li> <li>▪ Chlamydia trachomatis infection</li> <li>▪ Coccidioidomycosis</li> <li>▪ Colorado tick fever</li> <li>▪ Creutzfeldt-Jakob disease &amp; other transmissible human spongiform encephalopathies</li> <li>▪ Cryptosporidiosis</li> <li>▪ Cyclospora infection</li> <li>▪ Dengue fever</li> <li>▪ Echinococcosis</li> <li>▪ Ehrlichiosis (human granulocytic, human monocytic, or unspecified)</li> <li>▪ Encephalitis</li> </ul> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ E. coli – Shiga toxin-producing (STEC) infection</li> <li>▪ Giardiasis</li> <li>▪ Gonorrhea – sexually transmitted &amp; ophthalmia neonatorum</li> <li>▪ Hansen disease (leprosy)</li> <li>▪ Hantavirus infection and pulmonary syndrome</li> <li>▪ Hemolytic Uremic Syndrome – post diarrheal</li> <li>▪ Hepatitis B (cases &amp; carriers)</li> <li>▪ Hepatitis C (acute &amp; chronic infection)</li> <li>▪ Hepatitis (other viral)</li> <li>▪ Human Immunodeficiency Virus (HIV) infection</li> <li>▪ Influenza-associated hospitalization</li> <li>▪ Influenza-associated death in a person less than 18 years of age</li> <li>▪ Legionellosis</li> <li>▪ Leprosy (Hansen disease)</li> <li>▪ Listeriosis</li> <li>▪ Lyme disease</li> <li>▪ Malaria</li> <li>▪ Meningitis – any etiology</li> <li>▪ Mumps</li> </ul> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Norovirus (formerly called Norwalk-like virus) infection</li> <li>▪ Pelvic Inflammatory Disease (PID)</li> <li>▪ Pertussis</li> <li>▪ Poliovirus infection (nonparalytic)</li> <li>▪ Psittacosis</li> <li>▪ Q Fever</li> <li>▪ Relapsing fever – tick or louse borne</li> <li>▪ Reye syndrome</li> <li>▪ Rocky Mountain spotted fever</li> <li>▪ Rubella (acute only)</li> <li>▪ St Louis encephalitis</li> <li>▪ Salmonellosis</li> <li>▪ Shigellosis</li> <li>▪ Streptococcal disease (invasive, organism isolated from a normally sterile site)</li> <li>▪ Syphilis (early latent, latent, and congenital)</li> <li>▪ Tetanus</li> <li>▪ Toxic-Shock Syndrome (staphylococcal or streptococcal)</li> <li>▪ Trichinosis</li> <li>▪ Varicella (chickenpox) – lab not necessary</li> <li>▪ Vibriosis</li> <li>▪ West Nile virus infection</li> </ul> |
