WHAT TO BRING TO YOUR WIC APPOINTMENT

at _____ am/pm. If you are unable to keep your appointment, please call the WIC office to reschedule. Please be on time for your appointment. If you are more than 15 minutes late, we may have to reschedule your appointment. If you do not keep this appointment or contact us to reschedule, your WIC file will be closed. **Your appointment will take at least 1 ½ hours. Please do not bring a child with a contagious illness.**

WE WILL NOT BE ABLE TO GIVE VOUCHERS UNTIL YOU BRING:

- Acceptable proof of income
- Acceptable proof of identification
- Acceptable proof of residency
- WIC ID packet, if you're currently on the program.
- A prescription from doctor for special formula. Our standard formulas are Similac Advance, Similac Sensitive, Similac Sensitive R.S., Isomil Advance Soy, Similac Go & Grow, Similac Go & Grow Soy. Other formula is available for certain medical conditions with a doctor's prescription and approval of WIC R.D. No low iron formula is given.
- Any immunization records you may have.

ACCEPTABLE PROOF OF INCOME

Your must bring written proof of income for everyone who works in your household. Bring ONE of the following:

- All pay stubs from the past month for everyone working in the house
- Signed statement from employer indicating gross cash earnings for a specific period
- Current Medicaid Card
- Military Pay: Recent Leave and Earnings Statement
- Public assistance or welfare payments: Check stub/award letter stating current amount of earnings
- Alimony and child support: Divorce decree, Award letter, Copy of check received, Letter from source
- Unemployment Compensation: Unemployment letter/notice

ACCEPTABLE PROOF OF IDENTIFICATION

Bring ONE of the following forms of identification for each person you want to get on WIC

- WIC Voucher packet/ID card
- Driver's license
- Current Medicaid Card
- Birth certificate
- Military ID
- Hospital card/bracelet (Infant only)
- Pay Check Stubs (last 30 days)
- Voter Registration card
- Letter from Human Services (for foster child)
- Passport
- Work or school ID
- Letter from midwife (for home births)

ACCEPTABLE PROOF OF ADDRESS

Bring ONE of the following. All documents must include a family member's name and address. PO Boxes are not acceptable. Current = within last 30 days.

- Current utility bills (gas or electric) with service address
- Current Medicaid Card with address attached
- Current bank statement
- Rent or mortgage receipts for lodging/housing
- Pay check stub with address
- Any current bill
